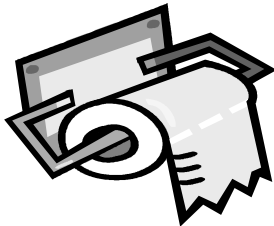
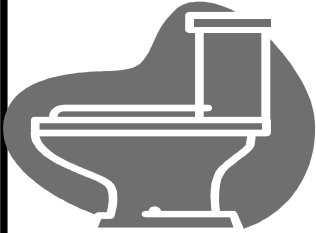
***Class size is limited to 20 so residents need to sign up at the clubhouse for each class time they plan on attending. You may attend more than one!***

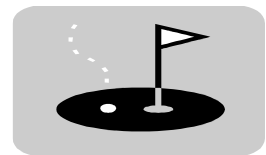
