



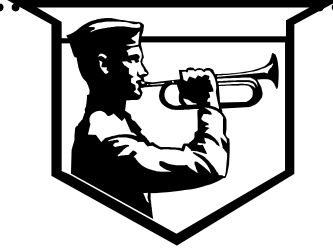

## Holiday Decorations

Just a reminder about the Association Rules for putting up seasonal decoration; the rule states:

Holiday decorations and/or seasonal decorations (Halloween, Thanksgiving, Christmas, Hanukkah, etc.) are permitted during the appropriate holiday season upon the exterior of any home on a temporary basis. Temporary shall mean that such decorations may be installed not earlier than twenty-one (21) days prior to any given holiday and removed not later than fourteen (14) days following such holiday.
