What to expect the day of the flight:

- Arrive at Lambert Airport at 4am. You will be paired with a Guardian for the day.
- Arrive at Baltimore-Washington airport, greeted by a water cannon salute.
- Bus tour of WW II Memorial, Korean, Vietnam and Lincoln Memorials, as well as Washington, D.C.. You will tour Arlington National Cemetery and experience the Changing of the Guard at the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.
- You arrive back in St. Louis around 8pm for a Welcome Home Celebration at the airport attended by friends and family.
