Rear yard setback requirements for room extensions, additions, decks, or patios must meet City Zoning Codes. In no event, may a room extension encroach within thirty-five (35) feet of the rear property line. Decks and patios, if approved by the ARC and City of Lake St. Louis, may not encroach within fifteen (15) of the rear property line.
