



Dear Residents:

The Heritage of Hawk Ridge Association has a contract in place for snow removal provided by Lawn Authority. They provided our snow removal last winter. The contract covers snow removal and calcium applications as long as the amounts fall within the terms of the contract. We are using resident “snow captains” to be the point of contact on making a judgement call when the weather forecast is in question and to accurately convey actual accumulations to the snow removal company. Driveways are hand shoveled with polyurethane shovels.

Several residents have chosen to “opt-out” of services. Please be advised that in an effort to avoid confusion and error on the part of the snow removal company, if you choose to opt-out, you will be required to **opt-out of all services** without exception. It will remain an “all or nothing” service. If you choose to opt-out of services, you must complete and sign the form below and return to us & place an orange ribbon on your mailbox to alert the snow contractor. Orange ribbons will be available at the Clubhouse.

We recommend that you do NOT park on the street during bad weather. In years past, several vehicles were hit. Additionally, if you leave a vehicle in your driveway, the snow removal contractor will NOT remove snow from your driveway for liability reasons. As such, please park all vehicles in your garage.
