Dear Residents:

On behalf of the Board of Directors for Heritage of Hawk Ridge Community, please accept the following as a reminder of the rules governing pool use:

Children are allowed according to the following schedule:

- Tuesday 12:00 pm – 5:00 pm
- Thursday 12:00 pm – 8:00 pm
- Friday 11:00 am – 3:00 pm
- Sunday and Holidays 10:00 am – 5:00 pm

These hours for children have been slightly revised from last year. We tried to allow for a variety of times and days. Again we want to remind everyone that HHR is a 55 plus community and continues to grow in size. Pool hours for children are designed to allow residents to enjoy some time at the pool without children present. We are also trying to accommodate planned pool activities. Please follow the assigned hours above.

Only 4 guests per household are allowed at the pool. This insures that residents always have the majority use of the pool. While we understand some may have more guests than the rule allows, use of a public pool may be more appropriate for the larger numbers. Rental of some pool deck space is also an option, please contact Maggie for details.

Residents (owner(s) of the property) **MUST** accompany their guests at all times. If children are disruptive, they may be asked to leave. Adult children must be accompanied by the resident as well.

Please use common courtesy – no splashing.

Squirt guns and large floatation devices (larger than a single person raft) are not allowed. Float rings are allowed.

Umbrellas must be lowered when you leave – failure to do so makes them susceptible to weather and storm damage.

Please review these rules and discuss them with your guests.
