8:45am: Meet at Heritage at Hawk Ridge Clubhouse at 225 Pigeon Dr. in Lake Saint Louis.

9:00am: Depart promptly on our motor coach

Our first stop will be the nationally-famous Swiss Meat and Sausage Company, located in Swiss, MO. Sample and shop for hickory smoked ham, bacon, turkey and more than 50 varieties of award-winning sausages and brats. You will want to bring your small coolers to store your purchases.

Enjoy a traditional German schweineschnitzel (pork) dinner, with red cabbage, German potato salad, and bread pudding with caramel sauce in the Vintage Restaurant at Stone Hill Winery, with entertainment. Afterward, tour Stone Hill Winery's unparalleled wine cellars, followed by a formal tasting of the winery's award-winning wines. Time for shopping here too.

Tour the Old German School Museum. Costumed docents will interpret artifacts, and answer questions about early German Hermann. This will also be the best place in town to purchase authentic German baked goods to take home.

Enjoy holiday shopping at downtown Hermann businesses and at the international Christmas Market, Kristkindelmarkt Festhalle.

4:00pm: Depart Hermann for home.

5:00pm: Arrive back at the HHR clubhouse.

Tour includes transportation, lunch/entertainment, all gratuities, wine tasting and cellars tour, museum and Festhalle admissions and the services of our tour guide, Linda Koenig.
