



2nd Annual Crazy Eight Classic



New for 2017, in case you haven't heard, there will be a total solar eclipse on August 21, held during the time we are having our event. Each participant will receive solar eclipse viewing glasses and a commemorative golf ball. **This is an outing you will NOT want to miss, sign up with Angie in pro shop.**

What is Crazy eight – simply put, Crazy Eight is playing the HHR course in backwards fashion. There are 8 holes playing from regular tee boxes to different greens. This year, we will play the 8 backwards holes twice, so the outing will have a total of 16 holes, making it a Sweet Sixteen event.

What time is the event- check-in is from 10:30am to 11:00am; play begins at 11:30am. Solar eclipse is at approx. 1:15pm. It could take 4 hours to complete the outing, considering two foursomes on each hole, and a slowdown due to the total solar eclipse. Your patience is appreciated!

Who can play – this outing is open to all residents of HHR **AND** non-residents who are annual golf members of the HHR course. This event is limited to the first 64 people who register with Angie at the pro shop, and pay at the time they register. Registration begins on March 13, 2017. Registration ends on July 31st. In the event that all 64 spots are not filled by 7/31/2017, the event will then be open to non-residents and non HHR golf members starting on August 1, 2017. Build your foursome now, and sign up before it is too late! If you don't have a foursome, Angie can pair you up with someone else.

How much does it cost- for golf members who also own a cart, the cost is \$7.00 per person (covers prizes); for golf members who do not own a cart, the cost is \$14.00 per person (covers prizes and cart); for Residents of HHR who are not a golf member, the cost is \$25.00 per person (covers prizes, cart and green fees).

Rules – this is not a scramble; you will be playing your own ball. All 8 holes are considered a par 3. We will play the 8 holes twice for a total of 16 holes in the event.

No Gimmies, putt every hole out. To help speed up play, the **maximum score on any hole is 6.**

No mulligans. If you hit into water, take a penalty stroke and drop on the other side of the water

Prizes – The low score for both the Men and Ladies division will each receive a **2017 Crazy Eight Trophy**. There will be **10 cash prize winners** this year, paid as follows: 1/10th of cash to lowest score in men's and women's division; 1/10th of cash to 8th place in men's and women's division; 1/10th of cash to 16th place in men's and women's division. And 1/10th cash for closest to pin on Crazy holes #1, #3, #4. The final 1/10th cash prize will be based on a drawing of all participants.
