Notes from the Advisory Board meeting April 27, 2020

Below is a list of property projects you will see happening in the next 2-3 weeks:

- Pool repairs are complete, and the pool is being filled. The opening date and rules will be announced when we hear from St. Charles Public Health officials.
- We will replace three street signs that are in bad condition with new ones and all other street signs will be straightened and the posts painted.
- The clubhouse front fountain and waterfall will be opened for the season.
- The streets in Phase 2 (Barn Swallow, Redstart, Song Sparrow) will have the joints filled with sealant. Concrete repairs are being made to damaged sidewalk areas.
- Landscape beautification will be done on the waterfall hill area.
- A new light kit is being installed in the fountain behind the Pro Shop.
- A new streetlight will be installed on Hawks Landing Drive for increased street lighting just past the gate and guard shack. This may happen in June depending on Cuivre River scheduling.

The Advisors have been actively working on steps to prepare for the Board transition from Lombardo Homes. This is anticipated to be around August.

Bids and planning are progressing on dredging our large 5.5-acre lake. More information and costs to come. Anticipated project date is early 2021.

The addition of a new horseshoe pit(s) was discussed and tabled at this time.

Future upgrades to the microphone and sound system will be looked at in the near future.

HHR will experience a soft opening from the Stay at Home orders implemented by Missouri because of COVID-19. The golf course will remain open to members and residents only until May 18th. We will re-evaluate in mid-May. May 4th the tennis courts will be open for tennis and pickleball and the bocce courts will also be available for play. Please refer to the restrictions found at Showmestrong.mo.gov which is still requiring 6 foot spacing from non-family members. As Missouri officials monitor the spread of the virus, we will notify you if additional activities and potential social events can take place. Please be patient and safe and check you HHR emails often.

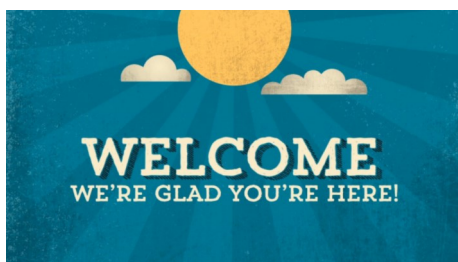
More Neighborhood News

CityBeat By: Gary Turner, HHR Resident & Alderman, Ward I

During April the Board of Aldermen held one meeting via videoconferencing, which was accessible to the public. The following actions were taken:

1. The Board awarded a contract to Gershenson Construction for the resurfacing of the city hall parking lot.
2. Awarded a design contract to Hoerner & Shifrin for Old Hwy N Phase 2 Improvement project.
3. Accepted the streets and stormwater collection systems in Mill Creek, Plat 1 subdivision.
4. Authorized execution of an Escrow Agreement with McBride providing for continued maintenance of the streets and storm sewer system to be dedicated to the City in the Mill Creek, Plat 1 subdivision.
5. Authorized execution of an Escrow Agreement with Windsor Park LLC guaranteeing completion of grading and installation and maintenance of erosion control measures for the Windsor Park subdivision.
6. Authorized execution with Windsor Park LLC providing for maintenance, repair and restoration of street improvements or a portion of Freymuth Lane.
7. Authorized acceptance of streets and stormwater collection systems located in the Wyndstone Plat One and Wyndstone Plat Two subdivisions.
8. Authorized execution of Escrow Agreements with McBride Duello, LLC providing for continued maintenance of the streets and storm sewer system dedicated to the City in plats one and two of the subdivision.

Next regular scheduled Board meeting is May 4. Whether it will be a videoconference or in City Hall depends on meeting restrictions due to the coronavirus restrictions. The Board has agreed to delay further design of The Meadows Park until reopening of the shopping center has been achieved and the City revenue picture for next fiscal year beginning on July 1, 2020
