Most of our agenda will focus on possible day trips for the remainder of year. The following 1-day trips are ideas for discussion at the meeting:

1. Kimmswick or St. Genevieve, both with many historical buildings and shops. Eat at local restaurant.
2. Hannibal. Take the hop-on, hop-off trolley (\$15) to visit Mark Twain Museum, Gardens, Huck Finn's house. Becky Thatcher's house, Big River Train Tower. Plus, others. Eat at Rustic Oak Grill & Pub.
3. Route 66 Tour. Start at Wildwood with an agenda, i.e., go to Cuba and stop at Bob's Gasoline Alley and other historical places, go to Merrimac Springs near St. James, and eat at Sybil's.
4. Cahokia Mounds, IL - largest pre-Columbian city north of Mexico. Grand 'plaza/twin Mounds," Monks Mound and the Stockade and the Woodhenge reconstruction. Lunch nearby.
5. Rocheport, MO. Walk the Katy Trail along river through the Rocheport Tunnel. Visit the galleries and fine crafts gift shops. Go to Le Bourgeois Blufftop Bistro and Winery which overlooks the river.

6-10. We have 5 more 1-day trips for your consideration that will be handed out at the meeting. This will allow all members to vote on the selection of trips this year.

+++ We are also looking into bus tours of various city locations such as The Hill, the National Blues Museum and, the Landmark Grand Center Arts Center.

We will also have suggestions for several 2-day trips awaiting the new rules for overnight stays. We will have handouts for the many trips we have on our list. We will take any ideas our members may have.
