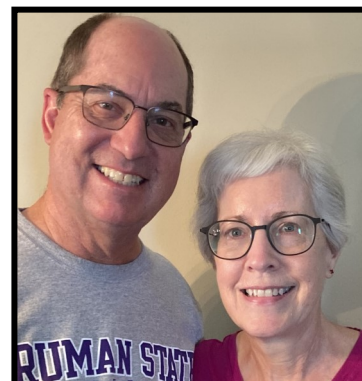

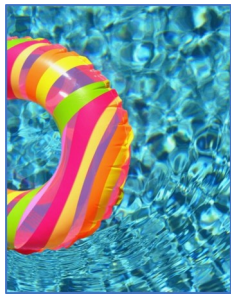
Kona Ice will be at the clubhouse parking lot after the parade (about 11).

Kicking up some dust!

A lot of activity has begun heading south on Lake St Louis Blvd. Two subdivisions have been approved (in Ward 2) as well as work on the Blvd itself. Construction will be lengthy and more work is scheduled for the Blvd in 2023.

Please be patient and careful when traveling that way.

Directly on the South-East corner of the Blvd and HR Trail will be the Aventura subdivision. This is an apartment complex of 5 3-story buildings for a total of 144 units.

Continuing East on the Blvd, will be the Montage subdivision. The Montage is a mix of homes, apartments, and villas and will contain (up to) 36 homes, 240 multi units and 167 townhouses. ALL units with the exception of the homes are scheduled to be rentals.

As the city has currently scheduled for 551 rentals at this corner, they have placed a 90 moratorium on all new rental proposals to have the opportunity to review the zoning plans.
