Randy and Ginger Gettman

Who needs a glass slipper when you can pick up a dropped shoe on a college staircase and meet the woman who will become your wife? That's how it was for Randy and Ginger Gettman, new to the HHR community, who have dedicated their lives to helping others.



Randy taught elementary school for 14 years before becoming an elementary school principal. "I loved watching kids grow and learn to do things they didn't think they could do," he said. As a teacher he influenced roughly 20 kids a year while as a principal he could hire the right people, influence hundreds and add diversity to his school.

Randy is also heavily involved with Morningstar Church, a non-denominational, community-oriented church that is heavily focused on meeting people's needs with such programs as a Backpack Ministry, providing food for roughly 200 families on weekends; an addiction recovery program and physical programs such as Yoga.

Ginger, with a Master's degree in Gerontology, became a nursing home administrator, hired staff and developed a variety of programs for senior care facilities. It's a career that lasted for 38 years. "I always made sure there was a clear direction, that the right people were hired, especially a well-qualified gerontologist."

Ginger's care of seniors in these facilities included making sure there was good food and an active environment. Her passion for them helped seniors in her care achieve quality of life and gave them a reason to get out of bed in the morning.

In 2007 Ginger purchased the first home that she converted into independent living for five residents who didn't need a nursing home but did need assistance, primarily with meals and medications. Now Ginger has retired and their sons have taken over responsibility for these homes, which now number 20.

The Gettmans recently took 3 of their 7 grandchildren to the Wisconsin Dells. They have traveled extensively and plan to continue doing so, all the while loving their HHR lifestyle. It's a very different lifestyle from the one they're leaving behind . . . 180 acres in Winfield and no neighbors. "We're really happy to be here, getting to know people and getting involved," said Randy.

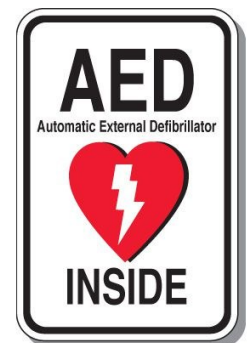
