If you already paid your dues but have not paid for this month's tasting, then you just need to pay the \$10 tasting fee. And if you have not paid your dues, but want to attend as a guest to see if this club is for you, you can come as a guest and need only pay the tasting fee. Just give us a note to that effect.

We need to know that you are coming and have your check dropped off at the front desk by noon on Tuesday, March 19. This is so we know how many tasters are attending and how many bottles of each whiskey we need to buy.

Guests of residents are also allowed to attend with a resident. They can not join the club, so you only need to pay for their tasting fee and bring a glass for them to use as we have a limited supply of tasting glasses and they are reserved for paid members. Just provide their names when you drop off the check.

If your spouse or a neighbor wants to come and just listen to the tasting presentation but not taste, then let us know they are coming as a non-taster and they can attend at no cost. They can also bring their own beverage of choice to drink while the rest of us are tasting whiskey. Just give us their name so we know who is coming as a non-taster.
