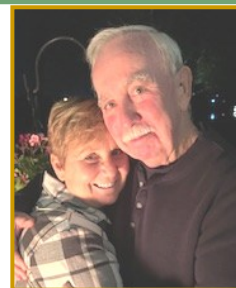




### **Bernie and Nancy Bulte**
