

Heritage at Hawk Ridge Golf Committee

General

The Golf Committee was formed to act as a liaison between the Heritage of Hawk Ridge (HHR) Residents, Board of Directors, Property Manager and the Golf Course Management company. The Golf Committee is comprised of HHR residents who are interested in the game of Golf. These voluntary positions generally span a three-year period with the committee's goal of making our course a fun and enjoyable experience.

Membership

The committee consists of seven voting homeowners and three non-voting members. The members should have a basic knowledge of golf and utilize the course on a regular basis. The committee members serve as volunteers with a three-year term limit.

Meetings

Meetings are held once a month or as needed.

Mission statement

Manages Tournaments in conjunction with Golf Course and Pro Shop Teams. Identifies Golf course issues and reports them to the HHR Property manager for resolve.

Works with the HHR Board liaison to report any issues directly affecting the committee and or golf course amenities.

Golf committee duties

Maintain check lists for tournaments to help committee members.

Formulate tournament plans and host HHR Tournament Events.

Attend Monthly scheduled meetings.

Review tournaments or fundraising events, in conjunction with the pro-shop manager as it relates Revenues, Costs etc. assessing if each of the tournaments should be continued.

Will be actively involved in Pro Shop Improvement Projects.

Will review the Reserve study and Five year plan and help coordinate projects as needed.

Will provide feedback and suggestions to the HHR Board of Directors via the golf liaison regarding golf course improvements to enhance the resident/player experience.
