New Rules for Golf Committee Sponsored Tournaments effective 2026 Golf Season:

- When signing up for a tournament, the entire team (Two-some or Four-some depending on that tournament's format) must pay their fees at the time of signup – no exceptions.

- Fees must be paid with Credit or Debit Card. Cash or checks will not be accepted.
- If you want to play in a tournament and don't have a complete team (Two-some or Four-some depending on that tournament's format) you will enter your name on the waiting list portion of the Registration Form. Once there are enough players to pair you up, you (and the other members of your team) will then be required to pay for Registration before your team's entry is accepted.
- There will be no cash payouts; rather, prizes will be awarded in the form of an HHR Pro Shop Gift Card.
- These rules do not apply to events in which the collected fees are not processed through the Pro Shop.
