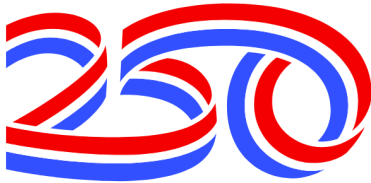

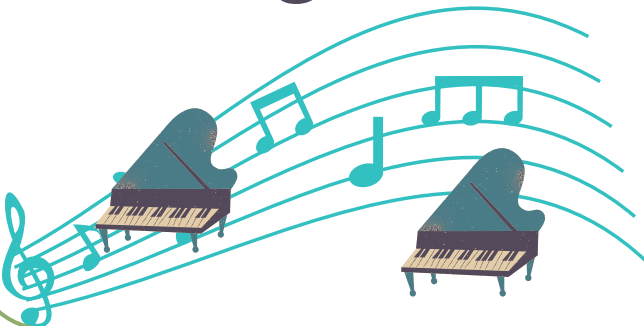

**ATTENTION HHR PICKLEBALL PLAYERS**

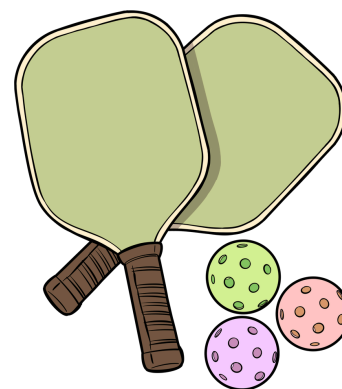
Come join your neighbors for pickleball every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday morning starting between 8 - 9 am, depending on the weather.

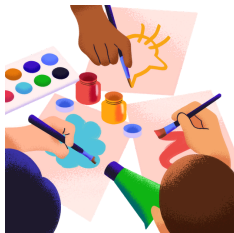

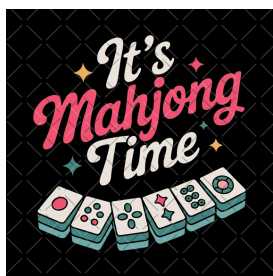

## Whiskey Club

We tasted five great Scotch whiskeys last month with great presentations by Steve Molina of Grey Eagle Distributors. He was very informative and knowledgeable. This month, we will have Jonas Buxton from Bare Wood Spirits. Bare Wood Spirits is a local distillery with a unique process. They begin with carefully selected barrels of whiskey and then use a patented bottle design to introduce a curated stave of wood directly into each bottle. That stave is selected by species, toast, char, smoke, soak or finish creating small batch variations in a way no other bottle can. If you want to learn more and taste these variations, then come to the June tasting.



The tasting this month is on the 3rd Thursday, June 18, at 7PM in the clubhouse ballroom. If you haven't done so already, you can sign up for the club by submitting a check for \$10 per person for dues, made payable to HHR Whiskey Club. - The player with the most aces is Steve Aubuchon with 5.  
The player with the 2nd most aces is Larry Poropat with 4.
